Fundamentals of Salvation

When you consider the teaching about salvation, I believe you must include all of the elements of this doctrine. That would include those factors which caused us to be lost or condemned in the first place and how we overcome our condemnation. That which caused us to be lost is sin. Consequently, it becomes necessary to give an explanation of the Doctrine of Sin.

The teaching about sin describes the actions that caused us to be condemned. "Behold, the Lord's hand is not so short that it cannot save; nor is His ear so dull that it cannot hear. But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear" (Isaiah 59:1, 2). Violating God's righteous standard separates us from the Lord.

The Scriptures use three terms to define violations of God's standard—iniquity, transgression and sin. Each term has a different meaning, but all refer to a violation of God's righteous standard. This morning, I will be teaching the definition of these terms, the differences between them and how they apply to us regarding salvation.

This evening we will have LIFE Groups. I am going to ask the LIFE Group leaders to focus their time on prayer for our sick.

Next Sunday, I would like for all LIFE Groups to meet here at the building. We are going to focus our prayers on asking God's direction for the ministry at Ross Road.
